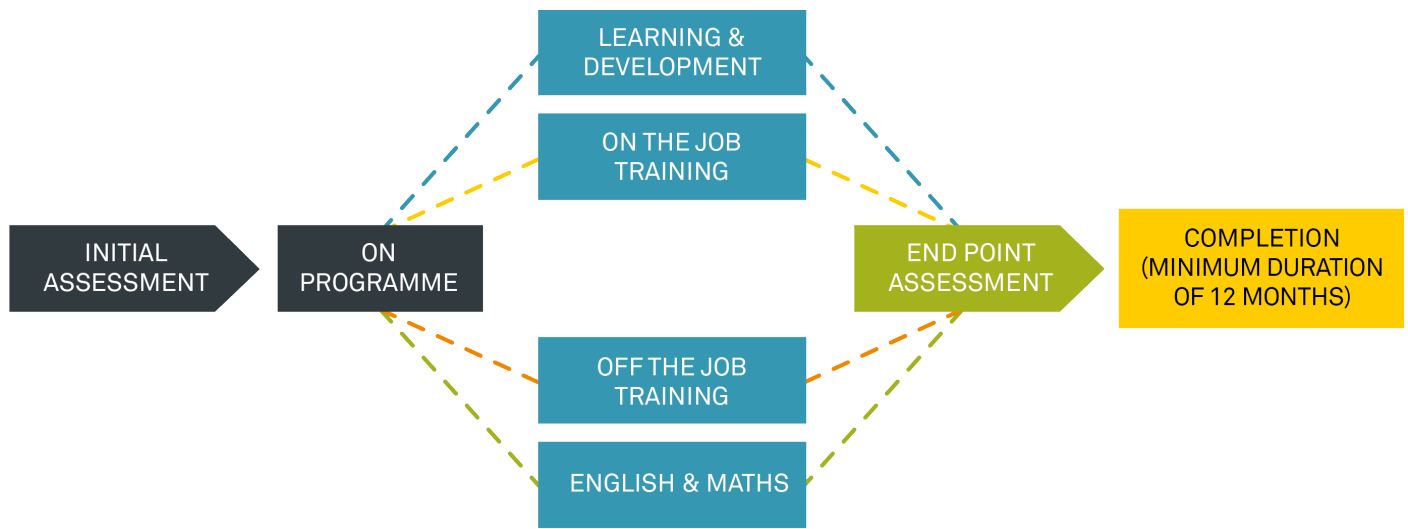


What an Apprenticeship Programme looks like

We tailor our Apprenticeship programmes based on the initial assessment and work with our apprentices through on the job training, learning & development programmes and English and Maths support.



The Apprenticeship team

Trainer

The Trainer will work with the employer and the apprentice to develop a tailored Individual Training Plan (ITP) built around the Apprentices needs. They will offer guidance, support and encouragement throughout the programme through learning activity visits in preparation for the End Point Assessment.

Internal Quality Assurer (IQA)

The IQA ensures the Apprenticeship hits the right quality standard throughout the programme and that the correct training is in place to prepare for the End Point Assessment.

Progress reviews

Every 10 weeks, the team and the Apprentice meet to discuss progress. This is a great opportunity for everyone to feedback on how things are going and discuss potential promotions, further training and future plans.

End Point Assessment (EPA)

The EPA represents the independent awarding body who regularly checks on the quality of the training being delivered. They will carry out the End Point Assessments and are there to support the Trainer, IQA, Employer and the Apprentice.
