MAKE TIME TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Work, school, friends, family, shopping and relaxing... So much to cram into our busy lives. It all takes time. Your very valuable time. So, we're not asking for your 'spare time' - we're asking you to 'make time'. Make time to make a difference to young people in Suffolk. Once a week with a young person is all we are asking. Catch22, commissioned by Suffolk Youth Justice Service, work with young people aged 10- 18 years old repairing the harm in the community and supporting them to complete their court ordered hours.

SUPPORT VULNERABLE YOUNG PEOPLE

The outcome for young people is to understand the impact of their offences. We ensure they understand the meaning of unpaid work and we aim to improve their confidence and emotional wellbeing. These court ordered hours are completed in the community or directly to the victim. Young people will have a better understanding of risks to themselves and others, enabling them to make more informed choices.

This is a very rewarding volunteer role.
